This book is a listing of the recommended movies from ESL Seminars. Many of you, if not most, wonder why we encourage our students to watch movies. That is a very good question, but the answer is even better.

We encourage, or more directly, we instruct our students to watch these movies to improve their English skills. We have selected older movies because of the perfect English. The English in these movies was created by screenwriters and playwrights that were English experts. The English is delivered by actors and actresses that speak their lines perfectly, with perfect pronunciations, diction, and intonations.

The reason these perfect English factors came together is a result of the "Hays Code". In 1930, Will Hays created the Hays (Production) Code, which set censorship guidelines for movies. and went into effect in 1930. However, the code was never enforced until 1934.

Before 1934, movie content was restricted by local laws, negotiations between the Studio Relations Committee, the major studios, and popular opinion rather than strict adherence to the Hays Code, which was often ignored by Hollywood filmmakers.

Not only was the level of English in the movies raised to a more formal and academic manner, but also moral issues that were regulated. Kisses could only last a few seconds, married couples had to have double beds, and so on.

In the early 1960's, films again began to deal with adult subjects and sexual matters that had not been seen since the early 1930's. British films such as Victim (1961), A Taste of Honey (1961) and The Leather Boys (1963) challenged traditional gender roles and openly con-



fronted the prejudices against homosexuals, all in clear violation of the Hollywood Production Code. In keeping with the changes in society, sexual content that would have previously been banned by the Code, was being included in movies. It was downhill from there..

This also affected the English being used. English degraded back to slang. There was also improper English sentence syntax and sentence construction. The quality of movies started to decline after 1960 and has never recovered.

What we have then is a time period in which movies, for the most part, demonstrate a high level of English. That English is formal and academic and is perfect for our use.

Movies also have an advantage. You see the "action" as you listen to the English. You are able to put action with dialog, and that will give you English in "context", exactly what you need to progress in your English skills.

Watch as many of these movies as you can. Download them and enjoy them, but above all, listen to the English and immerse in that English language!
