## IELTS Guarantee Program

Our IELTS Guarantee Program assures that any student/ test-taker who prepares for the IELTS exam and scores lower than Overall Band Score Requirement will be offered an IELTS course free of charge until the student reaches the Band Score Requirement. In order to qualify for the Guarantee Program, student must meet the following conditions:

### Conditions:

- a. 100% Attendance Record in all IELTS classes. Tardiness will be noted. If a student is more than 10 minutes late, he/ she will be marked absent for the class.
- b. 100% Homework ( If a student fails to do homework one time, the guarantee status will be considered null or invalid)
- c. Student must participate in the class activities and complete/turn his/her work in on time.
- d. Band score requirement (refer to the score requirement above)
- e. Student must ask for and sign the IELTS Guarantee Program at the start of his/ her IELTS Course.
- f. Minimum Duration of 12 weeks

**Important:** The student must comply with all the requirements and conditions. If a student failed to meet the overall band score requirement but conscientiously followed all the conditions (100%), CPILS will provide a free IELTS course fee for a month and 1 official IELTS exam. The student will only have to pay for dormitory, visa, electricity, etc.
